All photographic based work is welcome including digital, silver, alternative processes, and book arts. You do not need to be a member of TPS to enter. However, you may join TPS and enter this competition for a special discount.

Awards

First Place = \$500

Second Place = \$300

Third Place = \$200

Up to 5 Honorable Mentions may be awarded

Entry Fee

Entry fee is \$30 for 5 images; up to 10 total for an additional \$6 each. Students may enter the competition and join TPS at the same time for **ONLY \$40!**

Juror

Kenda North, based in Dallas, Texas, is Professor of Photography at the University of Texas, Arlington, where she has taught since 1989. Kenda earned an MFA from the Visual Studies Workshop (University of Buffalo). Her work is represented by Craighead Green Gallery and has been featured in over 50 one-person exhibitions. Kenda's work in hand applied dye transfer in the late '70s and early '80s marked her interest in color photography. She has explored a wide range of color processes in her career including dye transfer, Cibachrome, dye coupler prints and digital fine art printing. In 2009, Kenda received the *Honored Educator Award* from the SPE South Central Region.
